Cherry Tomato Caprese

INGREDIENTS

- Cherry Tomatoes
- Low-Moisture Mozzarella
- Basil
- Olive Oil
- Balsamic Vinegar

Directions:

Slice cherry tomatoes in half. De-seed if desired. Remove stems from tomatoes. Place pieces of mozzarella about 1/2" thick; cut pieces to size of tomatoes. Combine tomatoes, cheese and basil. Mix olive oil and balsamic and drizzle over salad.
